BUDGET/FUNDING

- ***What is the budget for the station?*** Cost breakdowns are as follows:
 - Personnel:
 - AFD: \$1.9 million
 - EMS: \$1 million
 - Apparatus:
 - AFD: \$680,000 for the fire truck; \$100,000 for the brush truck
 - EMS: \$120,000 for the ambulance.
 - Others costs (plans, construction, etc.) are separate.
- ***Do we have funding already?*** Yes, we have a preliminary start with funding already set, with a guarantee from the City to pay for the rest via [Resolution 20180524-035](#). As we move along in the process, Council approves the funding as needed at various stages.

GENERAL QUESTIONS

- ***When will groundbreaking occur?*** Soon! We are working on that now and hope to have a date set for some time in early fall. As soon as we know, we'll share it so you can add it to your calendar; we want you there!
- ***When will the station be complete and open?*** According to Public Works' timeline, the station is scheduled to open in June 2020.
- ***What is the City doing to ensure things stay on schedule?*** All of the respective departments involved are meeting every Monday morning to ensure things keep moving. We'll also provide status reports to Council as required in [Resolution 20180524-035](#).
